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## Description of the four communities

### Saas-Fee

This world-renowned, car-free glacier village lies on a high plateau 1800 metres above sea level, at the foot of the highest Swiss mountains, the Mischabel chain. As well as 100 km of ski slopes, a snowboard park, and 30 km of hiking trails, Saas-Fee offers lots more winter fun for young and old alike. Saas-Fee is the destination for sports enthusiasts from all over the world. Owing to the fact that no cars are allowed in this village, it has retained its romantic character, and the lively main street positively invites you to enjoy a gentle stroll round the shops.



### Saas-Grund

Saas-Grund offers its visitors an attractive, and very diverse range of winter sporting activities: 35 km of ski slopes, action points, downhill course, snow-tubing «Gstein» beautiful winter hiking trails, a natural and an artificial ice-rink, and an 11 km-long toboggan run; lots of winter fun for everyone. The snow-guaranteed, sunny ski area of Hohsaas with its impressive, challenging glacier piste, offers you a unique view over the 18 four-thousand-metre-high peaks of the Saas Valley, the highest mountains in Switzerland.



### Saas-Almagell

Saas-Almagell is the most southerly community in the Saas Valley. It is the home of Olympic skiers Heidi, Pirmin and Silvan Zurbriggen, and is an idyllic holiday resort, perfect for families with children. This village is a real insiders' tip among the many regular visitors who appreciate its homely atmosphere. Saas-Almagell offers an attractive range of sports activities: pistes with guaranteed snow from 1672 m to 2400 m above sea level, 3 km toboggan run, timed keep-fit circuit, snow tubing, groomed walking paths, 26 km cross-country skiing trail, ice rink etc.



### Saas-Balen

Saas-Balen being at the entrance to the Saas Valley is regarded as the gateway into the Valley. The small mountain village is very suited for lovers of the great outdoors, those who prefer their surroundings a little quieter and like to spend their holidays away from noise and stress. The ski-lift «Im Boden» is especially suited to ski and snowboarding beginners.

This natural holiday resort has a natural ice-rink, a direct return piste from the Hohsaas ski slopes, and, like Saas-Almagell and Saas-Grund, it lies on the 26 km-long Saas valley cross-country ski run. With the «Saas ski pass» and regular ski bus service more ambitious skiers can access all ski regions of the Saas valley in approximately 15 minutes.

## Sustainability in Saas-Fee

We take care of our «Pearl of the Alps» by actively protecting the environment. The foundation for creating a resort conscious of the environment and of quality was laid in 1951, when the community made the decision to keep the village car-free. Today we are always guided by the latest developments concerning the protection of the environment. Our model for sustainable or «gentle» tourism is the principle of «sustainable development». This means that all actions taken by the present generation which effect future economic, social and environmental development must not cause future generations to be restricted in their possibilities for development. Unspoilt nature and habitat are and will remain the prerequisite and basis for tourism. To achieve these aims, strategies for protecting resources are necessary to guarantee that tourism does not harm the environment. Saas-Fee has time and again played a leading role in ecological and sustainable development with various concepts and projects over the last few years:



### Alliance in the Alps 1996

Saas-Fee committed itself to the «Alliance in the Alps» project as a pilot community in 1996. This network of communities is an amalgamation of almost 150 communities throughout the entire region of the Alps. The member communities joined forces to realise the goals of the Alpine Convention for sustainable development in the Alps in a concrete way.



### The Q-Club

The «Quality-Club» label is awarded to businesses, hotels, holiday apartments, restaurants and many other businesses which come into contact with visitors in the Saas Valley which place great value on quality services. Note the quality sign in our list of hotels and apartments: «Quality-Club» – your guarantee of quality! All «Quality-Club» members also hold the grade I or II quality label for Swiss Tourism. The Saas Valley was the first resort in Switzerland to devote itself to quality in tourism and create a quality label carrying certain obligations. We offer our guests a guarantee of quality in their accommodation. If your accommodation does not correspond to the description given in the brochure, you can request a change of accommodation free of charge at the various tourist offices. A reservation in an excellent hotel or apartment encourages better quality and confidence and doesn't cost any more. The tourist offices are always pleased to receive your suggestions.



### A GAST resort: Your car can have a holiday too

The lack of cars in Saas-Fee contributes considerably to the relaxed holiday atmosphere and romantic character of the village where there is no stress from traffic. Guests benefit from the peace and quiet, the good quality of the air and the freedom of movement in the streets. 10 years ago, car-free resorts in Switzerland which care about a high quality of service and the environment joined forces to form the society of car-free Swiss resorts (GAST for short). In order to bring attention to the special efforts being made to achieve quality, various aspects of the quality of being car-free were defined, and their application is checked at regular intervals.



### Valais Excellence

Saas-Fee Tourism was awarded the new «Valais Excellence» label in December 2004. This consists of the familiar level II of the Quality Label on the one hand, and the internationally recognised ISO norms in the field of the environment and safety on the other hand. With the introduction of the «Valais Excellence» label, Saas-Fee Tourism will also be awarded level III of the Quality Label.



### The label «Energy Town»

Saas-Fee was awarded the status of «Energy Town» in June 2002. The label «Energy Town» represents the introduction of actual quality control concerning communal energy policies and is awarded to towns and communities which – in proportion to the possibilities at their disposal – go to exceptional lengths to implement energy and traffic policies in their community. Receiving the «Energy Town» label is not only recognition of the policy followed by Saas-Fee up to now concerning energy and the environment, but also represents a commitment to continue the work it has begun.

## Refuse management

Saas-Fee was the first resort in Switzerland to introduce fees for refuse bags in 1994. By means of this fee, residents are called upon to sort refuse exactly and to produce less refuse in general. Household refuse may only be disposed of in the official bags which carry a fee. You can obtain further information from the proprietor of your apartment. See also the notices in the resort.

## The appearance of the village and development planning

Saas-Fee has some of the most restrictive building and zoning regulations in Switzerland. All buildings must have a gabled roof and at least one third of the facade of a building must be built of wood. The typical Valais style of chalet can be maintained with these measures. In order to forestall overwhelming speculative building, the sale of apartments has been strictly limited. In this way, the glacier village of Saas-Fee has, in contrast to other resorts, managed to maintain a traditional village character.

## Notice from the resort of Saas-Fee local authorities

The resort's infrastructure will be partly closed from the beginning of May to mid June. If construction work is taking place there will be a certain amount of noise.

### Tax rates

In Switzerland you pay a visitors' tax, and you may wonder what happens to the money. The visitors' tax is used by the tourist associations for the improvement of the infrastructure (for example maintenance of hiking trails, children's playgrounds, park benches, signposts, visitors' animation programmes etc.). The Saas-Fee visitors' tax is included on your bill at the end of your stay.

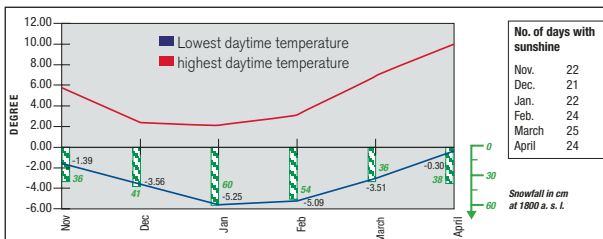





## NEAT – Valais comes that little bit closer!

The opening of the Lötschberg tunnel in December 2007 will lead to a shortening of the journey time from northern areas into the Valais region. Depending on the route this can make a difference of up to 70 minutes. A new rail junction in Visp will also shorten travelling times for our guests.



## Travelling by public transport

By train, you travel to Brig or Visp and change to the postbus which takes you to the four resorts in the Saas valley. There are hourly connections from Brig and Visp. The express bus service stops also at Saas-Grund but not at Saas-Balen. For Saas-Almagell, change at Saas-Grund (post office).

Swiss Travel System: Swiss Pass, Swiss Card, Swiss Flexi Pass, Swiss Transfer Ticket and Swiss Tour Pass will be taken into account by travelling with the postbus.

### Direct connection Goppenstein–Saas-Fee (Saas Valley)–Goppenstein

If you travel through the Lötschberg tunnel by train, take advantage of the postbus connection on Saturdays during the winter season. The first service from Goppenstein leaves at 10.30 a.m. and arrives in Saas-Fee at 11.42 a.m. On the return journey, the first bus leaves Saas-Fee at 9.10 a.m. and arrives in Goppenstein at 10.20 a.m. Further information is available from the postbus office in Saas-Fee. (Reservation obligatory, call +41 27 958 11 45.)

Check in your luggage at your home station and collect it at the postbus station in Saas-Fee or at one of the post offices in the Saas Valley. Seat reservations are essential for your return two hours before departure. Free seat tickets are available at the car station.

## Parking information

Saas-Fee is car-free! You leave your car in the covered car park or open-air car park (entrance through the new parking building, Terminals A+B setting down zone only) at the entrance to the village. You can take your luggage to your apartment by electro-taxi or with a handcart (handcarts are provided by the house owner or the tourist office). Your hotel will fetch you free of charge from the car park or the post office. From this moment on, you can enjoy your holiday without worrying about your car! Further information is available before leaving home from your holiday apartment owner or the luggage transport counter. The Saas-Fee guest card, which entitles you to a reduction of CHF 4.– € 3.– on the parking fee from the second day on, is available from your apartment owner. Please ask for it immediately after your arrival. In Saas-Balen, Saas-Grund and Saas-Almagell, there is sufficient public parking space (some of it chargeable), in addition to the private parking arrangements of the hotels and holiday houses and apartments.


















# Rates info and safety regulations

## First find out, then buy

Purchased passes cannot be exchanged, extended, altered or returned. EC cheques will not be accepted.

## Advance purchase

Passes valid from the following day can be bought after 15.00 (excepting full and half-day cards).

## Flat-rate tariff system for skiers

Skiers will not be sold single journey tickets, but only ski passes, full or half-day cards. An exception is made for alpinists who are suitably equipped (rucksack, touring skis, rope, etc.).

## Full and half-day cards and passes

These passes/cards are personal and non-transferable. A passport-size photograph is compulsory for 8 days or longer.

**Lost passes:** Key cards (from 2 days) are only replaced on presentation of proof of the card being blocked. Half-day and full-day cards are not replaced.

## Age limit for children

Children up to the 6th birthday are free if accompanied by an adult, with the exception of schools and similar institutions. Exception: children under 6 pay the normal child tariff on the Saas Balen village ski-lift. The age limit for children is the 16th birthday. From 14 an identity must be produced on demand.

Please ask at the cable cars for family reductions.

## Reductions for seniors

Seniors from their 61st year of age pay the group tariff rate for ski passes upon presentation of an official identification.

## Skiing adjusted to the conditions

The instructions of the ski slope maintenance services and the FIS regulations must be obeyed. The daily supervision of the slopes ends with the last check of the slope (see notices).

## The use of ski-lifts and chair lifts

These must never be used in the absence of staff or after the end of operation, even if the lift is still running.

## Withdrawal of ski pass

Irresponsible behaviour, such as the inobservance of the FIS regulations, signals and barriers, as well as leaving the marked and staked runs, will result in the withdrawal of the ski pass. There is a danger of death for skiers outside the glacier runs (glacier cracks).

For infringement of these rules the staff will confiscate the ski pass, which may be retrieved from the administration office the following day against the payment of a CHF 100.– € 67.– fine (Federal approval as of 1.1.89).

The misuse of the ski pass will result in its immediate confiscation, with no right to reimbursement.

## Skiing without a pass

The use of the facilities and ski slopes without a valid ski pass is subject to a fine and a police criminal charge.

## An accident – what to do?

Report any accident immediately to the next station or to a slope patroller, and give the most accurate location details possible. Bad weather, avalanche danger, unforeseen departure, interruption to services, breakdowns. If one, several, or all of the facilities go out of service due to the above reasons, the bearers of passes have no right to a refund.

## Accident or illness

In the case of an accident or illness, there is an entitlement to a refund. This requires the immediate handing in of the partially-used ticket, followed as soon as possible by a certificate from a doctor in the region, to the ticket office. In this case, a recovery during the holiday will require a new ski pass for the remaining days.

**In Saas-Fee a charge of ¼ of the standard price applies for big dogs!**

**Price reductions cannot be accumulated.**

## Connections Saas Valley

There are hourly bus connections between Saas-Grund, Saas-Almagell, Saas-Balen and Saas-Fee. The ski bus runs according to schedule from 6.33 a.m. until 8 p.m. and stops in all villages at different bus stops. The ski bus is valid until 7 p.m. by using a regional ski pass. Details and timetables are available from the local post offices or on the ski map.
